The following change is made to the Forest Plan through this amendment.

FOREST PLAN, CHAPTER 3 - MANAGEMENT AREA 20 - ADMINISTRATION, UTILITIES,  
COMMUNICATIONS

Replace the first paragraph on page 3-105 to read:

**Communications Sites**      The Forest contains 11 communication sites. There are four major sites: Big Mountain, Elliott Knob, Great North Mountain, and Rocky Mountain. There are seven secondary sites: Duncan Knob, Narrowback, North Mountain, Reddish Knob, White Grass Knob, Signal Knob, and Fore Mountain.
