NON-USE:

As per FSM 2231.61 (Gila Supp #23), I am informing you that you have incurred 3 years of Personal Convenience Non-Use. In order to maintain full permitted numbers you are required to stock up to 90% of the permitted numbers by the 4th year (2009). If you do not stock to within 90% of the permitted numbers at any time during the 2009 grazing season the permit can be reduced to the highest number stocked in the previous 3 years (2006-2008). In your case, because you have stocked zero cattle from 2006-2008 your permitted numbers could be reduced to zero, resulting in full cancellation of the permit. If you foresee that fully stocking in 2009 will not be possible, I would encourage you to visit with Stan Towner at the earliest possible time regarding stocking alternatives.

All assigned range developments identified in the Term Grazing Permit must be maintained to a functional status.
