

**NOTICE OF DECISION**

**Dip Vat Creek Fish Barrier Project**

The Spanish Fork Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest has completed an analysis of the Dip Vat Creek Fish Barrier Project. The fish barrier would keep brown trout out of the upper reach of Sixth Water Creek so that they are no longer competing with Bonneville Cutthroat Trout. The proposed fish barrier would be constructed using natural materials such as onsite boulders.

On January 18, 2006, the Responsible Official, Spanish Fork District Ranger Douglas H. Jones, approved the decision memo for the construction of this project. The Spanish Fork District, in coordination with Utah Division of Wildlife, will install the fish barrier which will be located in Township 7 South, Range 6 East, Section 32, Salt Lake Meridian, Utah County.

This legal notice provides notification of the final decision associated with this project. Pursuant to 36 CFR 2155.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal. Implementation may begin immediately.
