

## **PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED ACTION**

Northern Wasatch Front Restoration Project  
USDA Forest Service – Uinta National Forest  
Utah County, Utah

The Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, in cooperation with the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, is proposing to implement a watershed and wildlife habitat restoration project along the Northern Wasatch Front from Grove Creek to American Fork Canyon. The project area follows the east boundaries of Pleasant Grove and Cedar Hills, Utah.

The proposed project involves restoration on an estimated 25 miles of non-system roads and trails. The project would include barricading unauthorized motorized entry points, posting signs, and rehabilitation of roads and trails.

The project location follows the east boundaries of the cities of Pleasant Grove and Cedar Hills, in Utah County, Utah, in portions of Sections 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 22, Township 5 South, Range 2 East, Salt Lake Base Meridian.
