The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest is proposing to pipe water from Vern's Spring in Baldy Creek to the uplands east of Indian Creek. The pipeline will carry the water to two sites (Sections 25 and 36 T4S, R12W, and Section 2, Township 5 South, Range 12 West, USM) on the east side of Indian Creek where there will be a storage tank and a set of troughs to water the sheep.

The purpose of the proposed action is to provide water for sheep in the uplands away from Indian Creek. The need for this proposal is to provide water for sheep on the east side of Indian Creek so that the water gaps in the Indian Creek Fisheries enhancement fence can be closed. This will further reduce impacts to the spawning of fish by sheep watering in Indian Creek.

The Forest service is seeking public comment on the proposed action.
