

**NOTICE OF DECISION**

**Strawberry River Fish Habitat Phase III**

The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Strawberry River Fish Habitat Phase III proposal. On March 6, 2008 Forest Service Responsible Official Julie K. King approved the fish habitat improvement and stream stabilization project. The project is located along Strawberry River between Bull Springs Road and Highway 40.

This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to Forest Service regulations at 36 CFR 215. Appeals must meet the content requirements of 36 CFR 215.14. Only individuals or organizations who submitted comments or otherwise expressed interest in the project during the comment period may appeal. Appeals must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Deciding Officer within 45 days of the publication of this notice in Provo Daily Herald. This date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Timeframe information from other sources should not be relied on. The Appeal Deciding Officer is Uinta Forest Supervisor Brian Ferebee.
