SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT

TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System trails, road and parking lots within the area described in this order. The trails, road and parking lots within the area affected are located on the Salt Lake Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting May 6, 2022 through November 30, 2022 when the trails, road and parking lots are signed as closed.

- 1. **Being in or upon** the Albion Meadow trail (Forest Service trail #1006) Snakepit trail (Forest Service trail #1015 as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian, bicycles, and motorized vehicles. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]
- 2. **Being in or upon the** Albion Basin area below the Catherine's parking lot, Albion Basin road (Forest Service road #028) as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian, bicycles, and motorized vehicles. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
- 2. Any Federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The area closure includes the area below the Catherine's Lake parking lot, Albion Basin road (Forest Service road #028), Albion Meadow trail (Forest Service trail #1006), Snakepit trail (Forest Service trail #1015) located in Township 3 South, Range 3 East, Section 5 and Township 3 South, Range 3 East, Section 4 all within the Salt Lake Based Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety while ski resort crews and equipment are constructing the new Sunnyside lift.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- 1. This Order will be in effect when signed May 6, 2022 until November 30, 2022 when the trails, road, and parking lots are signed as closed.
- 2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
- 3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

- 5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
