

Motorboat Use Restriction in Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area
TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST
Juneau Ranger District

Order No. 10-05-33-22-02

Pursuant to **16 U.S.C. § 551** and **36 CFR § 261.50(a)**, the following acts are prohibited within the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area of the Tongass National Forest as shown on the attached map.

1. Possessing or operating a motorboat. **36 CFR § 261.58(n)**
2. Launching a motorboat except at a designated launching ramp (permittees only). **36 CFR § 261.58(r)**
3. Possessing or transporting any motor capable of propelling a watercraft through water by any means. **36 CFR § 261.58(w)**
4. Landing of aircraft, or dropping or picking up any material, supplies, or person by means of an aircraft, including but not limited to a helicopter. **36 CFR § 261.58(y)**

Pursuant to **36 CFR § 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from the Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Order is effective from June 2, 2022 through June 2, 2023.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. **16 U.S.C. § 551** and **18 U.S.C. § 3559, 3571, and 3581.**
