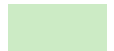

The permitted free use area is multiple slash piles from logging. The piles contain logs over 12ft. Removing logs from slash piles is authorized but any slash resulting from your activities must be put back on piles. Only dead and down ponderosa pine logs are available for take in the Free use area, This permit does not authorize motorized cross-county travel to scout for wood, however you may use your vehicle off road to gather wood.

Directions: Take 180 Northwest of Flagstaff for 18 miles. Turn right onto Forest Service Road 151 South for 1.5 miles. Slight left onto Forest Service Road 418 for 1 mile and the wood piles will be on the right.
