

Pike and San Isabel National Forests Cimarron and Comanche National Grasslands

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the San Isabel National Forest until further notice.

(1) Using any motorized vehicle on the Forest development road (FDR) or segment listed. 36CFR 261.54 (a).

That portion of FDR 298 (Alpine Tunnel 4WD) starting at FDR 298A (Williams Pass 4WD) T.51N., R.5 E., Sections 23 and 26 to the entrance of the Alpine Tunnel T.51N., R.5E. Section 22 as shown below.

Fursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e)(1)(4), the following persons are exempt from this order.

- (1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (2) Any person with a permit issued by a Forest Officer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
