# SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FORESTS

#### FOREST WIDE NUDITY

#### **PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following act is prohibited** on the National Forest System lands as described in this Order. All lands affected are located within the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests. This order is in effect July 22, 2022 through July 22, 2032.

1. **Being publicly nude** on all lands within the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests as described below and shown on attached map. [36 CFR 261.58(j)]

#### **EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

### **AREA DESCRIBED:**

All National Forest System lands located within the boundaries of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests.

#### **PURPOSE:**

To provide for public safety on National Forest system lands.

## **DEFINITIONS**

Publicly Nude-Being nude in any place where a person may be observed by another person. Any person is nude if the person has failed to cover the rectal area, pubic area, or genitals. A female person is also nude if she has failed to cover both breasts below a point immediately above the top of the areola. Each such covering must be fully opaque. No person under the age of 10 years shall be considered publicly nude.

# **IMPLEMENTATION:**

- 1. This Order will be in effect June 22, 2022 and shall remain in effect through June 22, 2037.
- 2. Attached map shows the areas affected by this Order.
- 3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6months imprisonment. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].
- 4. Further information regarding this Order may be obtained at the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests, Supervisors Office, South Jordan, Utah (801) 999-2103.
- 5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
