# **★** CONDITIONS!

Many forest roads are inaccessible due to snowy winter conditions. <u>Check out these links before you go:</u>

Be prepared for snow and ice on Forest Roads! Use traction tires or chains.

#### WINTER GEAR CHECKLIST

Always carry the following items in your vehicle when visiting the forest in winter:

- flashlight
- extra food
- shovel
- extra water
- map
- extra layers
- traction devices

#### **SAFETY REMINDER!**

Winter Safety! DO NOT use your GPS to navigate through the forest. If possible obtain paper maps. Watch for signs that say, "road closed" or "not maintained for winter travel." There is a high potential to be stranded on snow covered roads with very little likelihood of someone finding you.

#### 1/12-1/15 ALERT FOR ALL DISTRICTS:

Expect high amounts of snowfall, whiteout conditions, & downed trees through Sunday causing hazardous road conditions. If travel is necessary use a high clearance vehicle with four-wheel drive and be prepared to self-rescue.

## Mt. Adams Ranger District

Atkisson Sno-Park: 2+ft light snow, road plowed regularly, parking area plowed 1/11 at 1300, grooming in process (some trails may be completed 1/12). Old Man Pass Sno-Park: 2ft snow, road/snow parks plowed regularly, groomed 1/9, icy road conditions on 30rd (Wind River Hwy) to the pass & beyond.

Koshko & McClellan Meadows: Plowed & groomed 1/9. Lone
Butte Sno-Park: No information available. Pineside Sno-Park: 2ft snow, road plowed to FR 82/8225, parking lot not plowed, not groomed. Flattop Sno-Park: No information available. Snow King Sno-Park: Not plowed/groomed. Smith Butte Sno-Park: Closed.

# Cowlitz Valley Ranger District

Wakepish Sno-Park: Groomed 1/9, continual snowfall & downed trees have slowed plowing. Orr Creek Sno-Park: Groomed 1/9. Johnson Creek Sno Park: No information available. Skate Creek Sno-Park: No information available.

### **Mount St. Helens District & Monument**

Marble Mtn. Sno-Park: Snow & high winds into Sun. Traveling on Forest Road 83 between now & Sun is not recommended. Climbing: Thurs-Sat: heavy snow, high winds, whiteouts, subzero wind chills, significant avi risk; Sun: high winds & low wind chills remain, significant avi risk, rds may not be passable; Mon-Fri: temps above freezing, avalanche risk at beginning of the week Science & Learning Center Schedule: Sat & Sun, 10am-4pm\*, SR 504 currently closed due to inclement weather.
