Be prepared for snow and ice on Forest Roads! Use traction tires or chains.

#### PINESIDE, SNOW KING, & ATKISSON SNO-PARKS:

There have been reports of an individual who has shown aggressive behavior & threatened winter recreationists near Pineside, Snow King, & Atkisson Sno-Parks. The US Forest Service, Klickitat County, and Skamania County law enforcement officers have been notified. Until the situation is resolved, we recommend avoiding Pineside, Snow King, & Atkisson Sno-Parks.

### Mt. Adams Ranger District

Atkisson Sno-Park: Reports of a dangerous individual (see above alert); it is recommended to avoid this area; plowed 1/24; 3" heavy snow on top of most recent grooming (1/20). Old Man Pass Sno-Park: Some trails groomed 1/23; upper loop will be groomed this week; snow = wet & heavy. Koshko & McClellan Meadows: No information available. Lone Butte Sno-Park: No information available. Pineside Sno-Park: Reports of a dangerous individual (see above alert); it is recommended to avoid this area. Flattop Sno-Park: No current information available. Snow King Sno-Park: Reports of a dangerous individual (see above alert); it is recommended to avoid this area. Smith Butte Sno-Park: Closed.

## **Cowlitz Valley Ranger District**

Wakepish Sno-Park: Closed due to downed trees preventing plowing. Orr Creek Sno-Park: Groomed 1/23; snow depth=66". Johnson Creek Sno-Park: Groomed 1/20; upper section of road is narrow and slushy; chains recommended as of 1/19. Skate Creek Sno-Park: Plowed 1/19; current snow conditions unknown.

### **Mount St. Helens District & Monument**

Marble Mtn. Sno-Park: Plowed 1/21; groomed 1/25; snow, but may be icy; some water across the trail in one section Climbing: Road plowed 1/21; heavy snow & rain end late Fri; weekend outlook: warm with summit temperatures well above freezing with a chance of rain & snow showers.
