## **FOREST ORDER**

## **Prohibited Acts on National Forest System Roads**

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(b)**, the following acts are prohibited on selected National Forest System Roads located within and immediately adjacent to the Big Thorne Project Area and administered by the Thorne Bay Ranger District of the Tongass National Forest:

- 1. Persons are prohibited from operating Motorized Vehicles, including Off Highway Vehicles (OHV's) and Over Snow Vehicles (OSV's) seasonally from December 1 to May 1 on the listed roads below [36 CFR 261.54(a)]:
  - a. NFS 3030700, MP 6.60
  - b. NFS 3030750, MP 0.00
  - c. NFS 3035190, MP 0.00
  - d. NFS 3035050, MP 0.00
  - e. NFS 3030850, MP 0.64
  - f. NFS 3030860, MP 0.00
  - g. NFS 3000348, MP 0.00
  - h. NFS 3000346, MP 0.00
  - i. NFS 3000347, MP 0.00
  - j. NFS 3000340, MP 0.00

This order is issued in compliance with direction given in the Record of Decision (ROD) for the Big Thorne Project Final Environmental Impact Statement (Big Thorne Project FEIS), signed by the Tongass National Forest Supervisor on June 28, 2013.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following are exempt from this order:

- Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
   36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)
- 2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)

These Prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.**This Order may be made more restrictive by temporary order issued by the Regional Forester or the Forest Supervisor as needed to promote public safety, and to protect public property and resources.


