EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from September 1, 2016 until September 30, 2016 unless rescinded earlier.

36 CFR 261.53 – Special Closures: It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the Protection of "Public Health and Safety" (Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)).

The purpose of this order is to ensure public health and safety from wildfire and during fire suppression activities associated with the Nez Perce Fire.

This order will remain in effect from September 1, 2016 until September 30, 2016 unless rescinded sooner when reconstruction is completed.

Area Description:

Forest Service Road No. 78154 at the forest boundary located in T4N, R6W, Section 18 and continuing in a easterly direction for approximately 3 miles to the private land boundary located in T4N, R6W, Section 16; Forest Service Road No. 1538 at the forest boundary located in T5N, R6W, Section 28 and continuing in a north and easterly direction for approximately 1 mile and continuing onto Forest Service Trail No. 4082 (Haystack Trail) to the terminus located in T5N, R6W, Section 34; and Forest Service Trail No. 7093 (CDNST-Nez Perce Trail) beginning at the junction of Forest Service Road No. 78154 in T4N, R6W, section 17 and continuing in a southeasterly direction to the junction of Forest Service Road No. 8695 located in T3N, R6W, section 14.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

- Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


Penalty:
