Open roads are symbolized by green lines on this map.

1. Private landowners and their employees are permitted access to their lands.

- 2. Federal, State and County employees are permitted entry to perform official duties.
- 3. Special permits may be obtained for legitimate reasons, contact ODFW, or USFS, Sisters R.D.
- 4. Not all roads indicated in green are open to OHV travel. Please check US Forest Service OHV regulations for roads specifically open to OHV travel on the Deschutes/Ochoco National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM),
