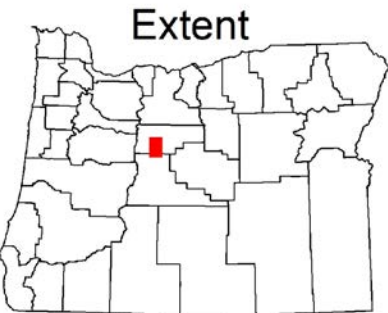

Roads not highlighted in green are closed to all unauthorized motorized vehicle travel from December 1st through March 31st.

- Open roads are symbolized by green lines on this map.
1. Private landowners and their employees are permitted access to their lands.
 2. Federal, State and County employees are permitted entry to perform official duties.
 3. Special permits may be obtained for legitimate reasons, contact ODFW, or USFS, Sisters R.D.
 4. Not all roads indicated in green are open to OHV travel. Please check US Forest Service OHV regulations for roads specifically open to OHV travel on the Deschutes/Ochoco National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM), www.fs.usda.gov/main/deschutes
 5. All "electric assist" vehicles are unlawful on closed roads.

- Objectives of Closure
Protect wintering deer and other wildlife from harassment and to protect wildlife habitat by controlling vehicle use, thereby:
1. Increasing deer survival during the winter
 2. Improving the physical condition and productivity of deer.
 3. Protecting and improving wildlife habitat
