YCC was established in 1971 as a work-learn-earn program that develops an understanding and appreciation of the nation's environment and heritage. This year's program is eight weeks long. Work is scheduled to start June 13 and end August 5, 2016. The salary is \$7.25 per hour.

The District Office, located in Unicoi, manages land in Carter, Johnson and Sullivan counties. Work projects include general trail maintenance, general recreation operations and maintenance around the district. The work is very physical and takes place outdoors, every day.

## **Applicant Requirements**

- Be at least 15 and not yet 19 years of age while enrolled in the program.
- Be a permanent resident of the United States.
- Have no history of serious criminal or antisocial behavior.
- Not have previously been enrolled in the program.
- Have a Social Security number.
- Be willing and able to work hard and participate in work projects.
- Be able to work 40 hours per week, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm Monday through Friday.
- Be able to provide their own transportation to and from work.
