

ORDER No. YRD-96-001

OCCUPANCY AND USE REGULATIONS

USDA - FOREST SERVICE

CHATHAM AREA - TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within all land located within and/or administered by the, YAKUTAT RANGER DISTRICT of the TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST, until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.58(a):

CAMPING FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN ALLOWED BY THE ORDER:

1. Camping or the establishment of a camp site shall be limited to a period of time not to exceed 10 consecutive days at any one location. At which time said camp must be removed, to include all personal property and litter, to an area no less than one (1) mile in distance from the existing camp site.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are EXEMPT from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
