Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas described on the attached map and described in this order within the Wasatch-Cache National Forest until further notice.

1. Possessing or using any motorized or mechanized wheeled conveyance on any portion of the 0.7 mile trail and/or boardwalk that surrounds Silver Lake. [36 CFR 261.55 (c)].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit.
- 2. Authorized Federal, state, or local officers, or members of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of official duty, when authorized by the District Ranger.
- 3. Individuals who require the use of a wheelchair or motorized cart.

<u>Area Described:</u> The 0.7 mile trail and boardwalk that surrounds Silver Lake in Big Cottonwood Canyon, Salt Lake County, Utah. (The area to be closed is delineated on the attached map - Exhibit A.)
