FOREST ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area on the Tongass National Forest:

1. Possessing or storing any food or refuse as specified in the order 36 CFR 261.58(cc)

No consumption of food or open beverages other than water within the area shown on attached map, except for persons consuming food or beverages within a designated area.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 EXEMPTIONS: the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Any other person meeting exemption requirements specified in the order.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
