

Camping:

- Upon arrival to the campground, locate an open site of your preference. Within 30 minutes of setting up camp, return to the fee station, fill out fee envelope, place fee inside and deposit in fee box.
- One camper/RV per site.
- Do not park on the grass.
- If there is not enough room in your campsite for an additional trailer or vehicle, please park it in one of the larger parking areas.
- Keep noise level low and respectful of other visitors.
- Basketballs and horse shoes may be checked out at the main office or rec building

Campfires:

- Campfires are allowed at all the campgrounds and within designated fire rings. Do not create your own ring in developed campsites.
- Always attend to your campfire by having someone near it while it's hot.
- Always extinguish your fire completely prior to leaving.
- Do not burn trash, such as bottles, cans or any other materials not intended for a campfire, as it creates more for staff to clean up.
- Should your campfire get out of the ring and start a fire, call 911 immediately.
- Check with our office or staff during high fire danger to see if any fire restrictions are in effect.

OHV (ATVs, Dirt-bikes, UTVs):

- No cruising through campgrounds. You are only allowed to drive from your site to the trail and back.
- Ride only on trails designated for that type of vehicle as shown on the map.
- Helmets and safety gear are recommended.
- Ride with younger children in the back of a group, not the front.
- Do not litter, and help us by picking up trash you might see.
- Respect others, and keep quiet from 10pm to 8am. Minimize noise in campgrounds at all times.
- Follow speed limits, and stop at STOP signs.
- Drive slowly through campgrounds and do not tune, rod or rev your motor in campsites.

With everyone's cooperation, we can keep the forest a great place to visit, for everyone!
