

ORDER # 89-12

OCCUPANCY AND USE REGULATIONS

PIKE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area described by this Order for the protection of property and public safety.

Area Covered By This Order:

National Forest System Lands known as the Monument Nursery Headquarters Administrative Site, approximately 30 acres in size, Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, T.11S., R.67W., 6th P.M. as shown on the map accompanying this Order.

THIS ORDER PROHIBITS:


Entering into or being within the fenced boundary of the Monument Nursery Headquarters Administrative Site, 36 CFR 261.53(f).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a USDA, Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation and providing goods or services to the USDA Forest Service.
