# Kisatchie National Forest Annual Day-Use Pass

This pass entitles you to unlimited day use in participating fee areas forest wide for one year from month of issue. Recreation day-use fee areas in the Kisatchie National Forest (KNF) include picnic areas, swim beaches, and boat launches.

Interagency Senior Pass, Interagency Access Pass, Golden Age Passport, and Golden Access Passport holders are eligible for a 50% discount on the KNF Annual Day-Use Pass at these expanded amenity fee sites.

This pass is part of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, approved by Congress in 2004. Your fees stay in the Kisatchie National Forest to help maintain and improve the recreation areas you enjoy. Your money may be used to upgrade facilities, improve information and customer service, and provide interpretation and environmental education. Please let us know what improvements you would like to see!

# What is covered:

This annual pass is honored at fee areas operated by the Kisatchie National Forest; areas operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; and selected areas on the National Forests and Grasslands in Texas.
