FOREST ORDER

Emergency Road Closure

Prohibited Acts

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), and to protect public health and safety, the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of Forest Service Roads 8050000 and 8000000 as shown on the attached map, within the Ketchikan-Misty Fiords Ranger District:

- 1. Using any motorized vehicle, to include those vehicles less than 50 inches in width, on the entirety of Forest Service Road 8050000 from October 21, 2021 through October 20, 2022. 36 CFR 261.53(e) and 36 CFR 261.54(a)
- 2. Using any motorized vehicle, to include those vehicles less than 50 inches in width, on Forest Service Road 8000000 beginning at or about 7.4 miles from the Fire Cove Marine Access Facility (also known as a Log Transfer Facility) and extending to the terminus of that road from October 21, 2021 through October 20, 2022. 36 CFR 261.53(e) and 36 CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt under this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(3).

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
