SPECIAL ORDER

FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

PAYETTE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the all Forest development roads described in this order, all within the Payette National Forest until further notice.

Using a road for commercial hauling without a permit or written authorization. (36 CFR 261.54e).

Roads Described

All Forest development roads within the Payette National Forest.

Reason for Closure

This prohibition is in effect for the protection and administration of the National Forest System. Any person wishing to use a Forest development road for commercial hauling should contact the Forest Supervisor or District Ranger to obtain a permit and to ascertain the special restrictions which may be applicable thereto.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both (16 USC 551).
