

SPECIAL ORDER

PAYETTE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the Forest Development road described in this order from the date of this order until further notice, all within the Payette National Forest.

1. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions.
36 CFR 261.58(g).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following people are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Forest Service administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.


Roads Described

Forest Service Road Number 50257 (also known as the Goose Lake Road) from it's intersection with State Highway #55 in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 26, T. 19N., R. 2E., Boise Meridian to the intersection with Forest Road Number 50269 (also known as the Brundage Ski Area Road) in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, T. 19N., R. 2E. Boise Meridian, a distance of approximately 4.2 miles.

Forest Service Road Number 50257 (also known as the Goose Lake Road) from it's intersection with Forest Road Number 50269 (also known as the Brundage Ski Area Road) in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, T. 19N., R. 2E. Boise Meridian, North on the Goose Lake Road for approximately 300 feet (the snowmobile parking area).

Reason for Closure: Management of the road and parking area.
