

CONDITIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE USE
MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts or omissions are prohibited on the Mark Twain National Forest:

1. Operating a vehicle in violation of the speed, load, weight, height, length, width, or other limitations specified by the order. For the purpose of this order, possessing or operating a motorized vehicle on any Forest Development Road in violation of Missouri State law. (36 CFR 261.54d)
2. Being on the road. For the purpose of the order, those roads and former roads having a physical barrier such as a gate, berm of earth, trench, post, former/grown-up road, or other device or all roads posted closed. (36 CFR 261.54e)
3. Being on a trail. Using a motor vehicle on a forest development trail unless designated for that use. (36 CFR 261.55a)
4. Operating a vehicle in violation of the width, weight, height, length, or other limitations specified. For the purpose of this order, vehicles over 50 inches in width are prohibited on forest development trails. (36 CFR 261.55d)
5. To possess or use a vehicle off forest development roads. (36 CFR 261.56)
6. Use by any type of traffic or mode of transport prohibited by the order. Prohibits the use or possession of bicycles or mountain bikes on trails designated for foot traffic only. (36 CFR 261.55c)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of an official duty.
