



All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs), Utility All-Terrain Vehicles (UTVs) and Motorcycles

Where You May Ride ATVs, UTVs and Motorcycles

Open Forest Service Numbered Roads

The Motor Vehicle Use Map, (MVUM), shows what roads are “Open to Highway Legal Vehicles”. You may ride on these Forest Service Roads in counties where ATV or UTV county permits are issued (see last page for list) providing you abide by Missouri State motor vehicle regulations. Not all counties encompassing the Mark Twain NF offer permits (see reverse for list). Motorcycles, ATVs and UTVs must meet Missouri State motor vehicle regulations (MSMVR) to be allowed on open Forest Service numbered roads.

MAPS

- The Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) can be viewed and down loaded at <http://www.fs.usda.gov/goto/mtnf/map/mvum>
- Mark Twain NF District/Visitor maps showing numbered Forest Service roads may be purchased at Forest offices for \$9.00.
- USGS topographic maps are available for \$8.00 each. Actual conditions on the ground may vary from the maps.

Open Forest Service numbered roads will be physically numbered with a post or sign. Roads not shown as open on the MVUM may not be ridden or driven.

To ride ATVs on numbered Forest Service Roads you must abide by MSMVR (Mo. Statutes 304.013, 301.010, 300.348, 307.198 & 301.705). These regulations are summarized below:

1. In counties that issue ATV permits, ATVs may be operated on county and Forest Service roads, with a county permit.
2. ATV operators must have a valid driver’s license. Operators under 16 years of age, with a learner’s permit, must be supervised by an adult. ATV operators under 16 years of age must be under direct supervision of a parent or guardian.
3. Persons under 18 years of age must wear a motorcycle helmet.
4. ATVs in Missouri must be registered with a state registration decal attached to the right front fork or frame.
5. No operator of an ATV is allowed to carry passengers unless the ATV was designed by the manufacturer to carry passengers.
6. ATVs cannot be operated in streams or rivers, except at designated crossings.
7. EVERY ATV that is operated on a road must be equipped with:
 - a. An adequate muffler system and a Forest Service approved spark arrester.
 - b. A good operating brake system.
 - c. A slow moving equipment emblem on the rear of the ATV at least two feet above the roadway.
 - d. A safety flag attached to the rear of the vehicle extending at least seven feet above the ground.
Lighted headlamp and tail lamp.

To ride UTVs on numbered Forest Service Roads you must abide by MSMVR (Mo. Statutes 301.010.304 & .032). These regulations are summarized below:



1. UTVs may be operated on county and Forest Service roads, WITH a county permit.
2. Operators of UTV's must have a valid driver's license.
3. No operator of an UTV is allowed to carry passengers unless the UTV was designed by the manufacturer to carry passengers.
4. UTVs cannot be operated in streams or rivers, except at designated crossings.

CHADWICK AND SUTTON BLUFF TRAILS -

With a Forest Service permit*, you may ride on designated motorcycle and ATV trails at Chadwick Motorcycle and ATV Use Area in Christian County and Sutton Bluff Motorcycle and ATV Use Area in Reynolds County. If you ride the roads that connect the trails at Sutton Bluff, you are ALSO required to have a Reynolds County permit, obtained from the Centerville MO Courthouse. Forest Service permits and brochures are available in Ava, Rolla, and Salem Forest Service offices, and at businesses near trail areas. *Daily permits sell for \$7/day; annual permits are \$45.

Requirements while riding at the Chadwick and Sutton Bluff Motorcycle and ATV Use Areas are:

- Ride on marked trails only.
- Motorized vehicles used on trails must not be over 50 inches in width, and are limited to motorcycles and ATVs.
- Working muffler and spark arrester required.
- Operable brakes required.
- ATVs, by definition, have low pressure tires, handlebars and are straddled.
- Utility All-Terrain Vehicles (UTVs) are prohibited from Chadwick trails; those less than 50" wide may use Sutton Bluff trails, with a permit.

WHERE YOU MAY NOT RIDE

Motorized Vehicles are NOT permitted off routes depicted on the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM), as "Open to Highway Legal Vehicles". (36 CFR 261.13). The MVUM can be viewed and downloaded at: <http://www.fs.usda.gov/goto/mtnf/map/mvum>.

PLEASE TREAD LIGHTLY

- Travel only where motorized vehicles are permitted.
- Respect the rights of hikers, campers, and others to enjoy their activities undisturbed.
- Educate yourself by obtaining travel maps and regulations from public agencies, complying with signs and barriers, and asking owner's permission to cross private property.
- Avoid streams, lake shores, meadows, muddy roads and trails, steep hillsides, wildlife and livestock.
- Drive responsibly to protect the environment and preserve opportunities to enjoy your vehicle on wild lands.

SAFETY FIRST!

You are encouraged to take and use the following equipment every time you ride: gloves and a helmet, eye protection, rain gear or cold weather equipment, maps, first aid kit, flashlight, and a fire extinguisher. It is also a good idea to take plenty of drinking water and snacks to last you for a hike in case you have to walk out after a breakdown. Remember, you can ride farther in one hour than you can walk in a day. Even if you're only planning a short ride, bring along some tools, a small tire pump, patch kit, tow strap, etc. A simple tool may be all you need to keep from walking.

Forest Service roads are shared by hikers, horseback riders, mountain bikers, cars and trucks. Please use caution and courtesy when encountering another user. Enjoy your ride!
