Instrument Choice Determination (Performed on NFS land)

Benefit/Use Test: If yes to any of these then *consider* use of a **procurement instrument**.

- 1. Is the FS the primary beneficiary of the activity?
- 2. Is the FS providing the specifications for the project?
- 3. Is the FS having the project completed based on its own identified needs?
- 4. Is the project controlled solely by the FS?

Partnership Test: (mainly Challenge Cost-Share & Participating Agreements, Stewardship Agreements):

- 1. Is there Mutual benefit mutual interest and supports both the Forest Service and Cooperator's mission/program?
- 2. Is there joint involvement in project activities/implementation?
- 3. Do the parties share/collaborate in the decision making process?
- 4. Is there cost-sharing; do both parties contribute to the project?
