ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR RESTRICTING THE OCCUPANCY AND USE ON THE HURON-MANISTEE NATIONAL FORESTS

KARNER BLUE BUTTERFLY

Under authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended (16 U.S.C. 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts are prohibited within area closures for the protection of federally endangered Karner blue butterflies (*Lycaeides melissa samuelis*) on the Huron-Manistee National Forests. The area closures are described and displayed in the Area Descriptions and on the Map Exhibits, which are attached and made part hereto.

- A. Possessing or using motorized vehicles, mechanical equipment, wagons, carts or bicycles within a closure area. 36 CFR 261.53(a)
- B. Camping or installing/using camping equipment, ground blinds or other structures on the ground within a closure area. 36 CFR 261.53(a)
- C. Being upon or within a closure area with a horse or other saddle, pack or draft animal. 36 CFR 261.53(a)
- D. Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal within a closure area. 36 CFR 261.53(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons will be exempt from the order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or Local officers, or members of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a valid permit in their possession signed by the Forest or District Biologist specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.


Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both under the authority of Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.



KARNER BLUE BUTTERFLY

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons will be exempt from the order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or Local officers, or members of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a valid permit in their possession signed by the Forest or District Biologist specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both under the authority of Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
