FOREST ORDER

OPERATING CHAINSAWS IN A DEVELOPED RECREATION AREA

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited in the Auk Village Campground, Auke Village Recreation area and Mendenhall Lake Campground, located on the Juneau Ranger District of the Tongass National Forest:

Occupying a developed recreation site with prohibited camping equipment prescribed by the order (36 CFR 261.58(d));

1- Operating a chainsaw within a developed recreation area.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

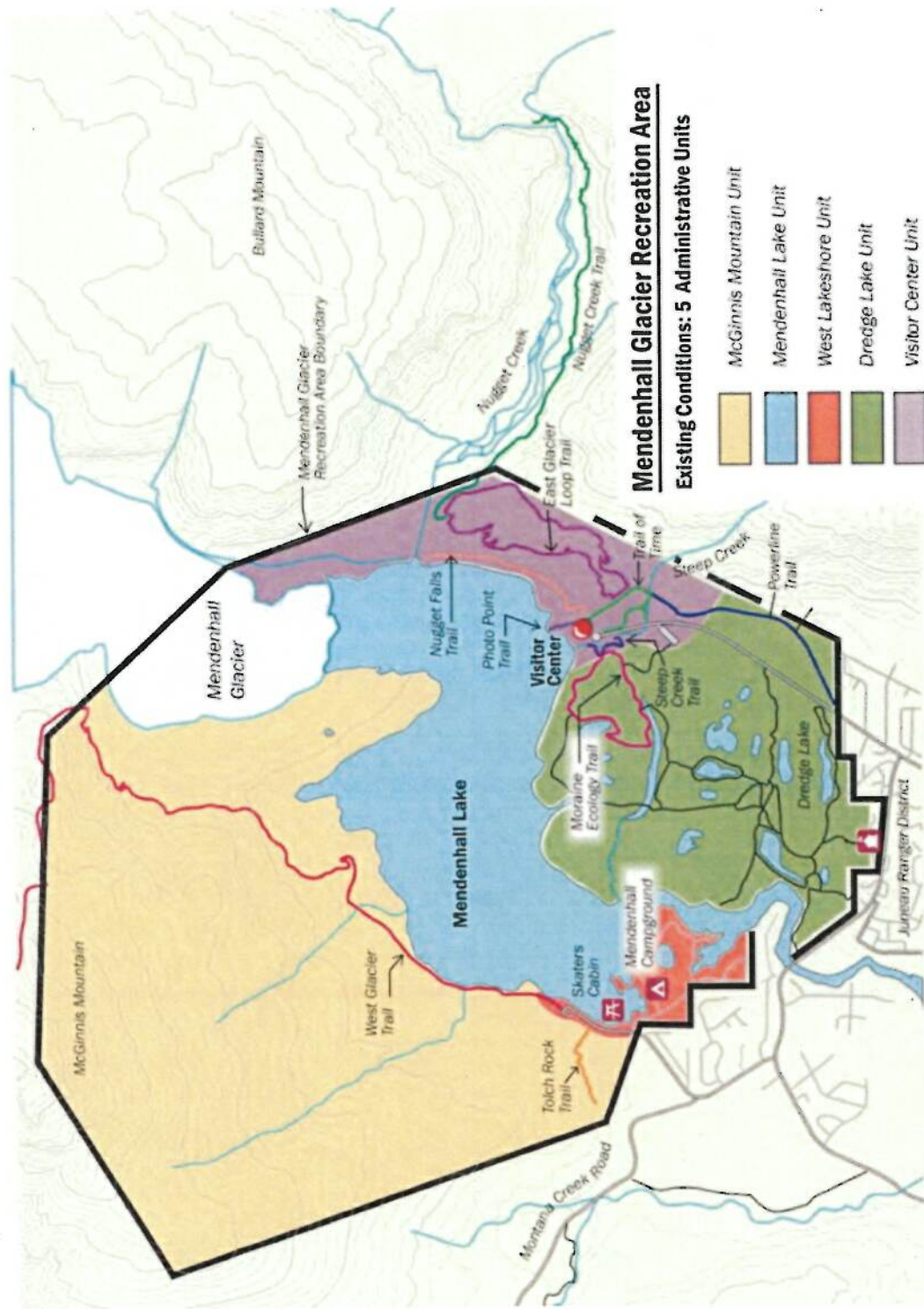
These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

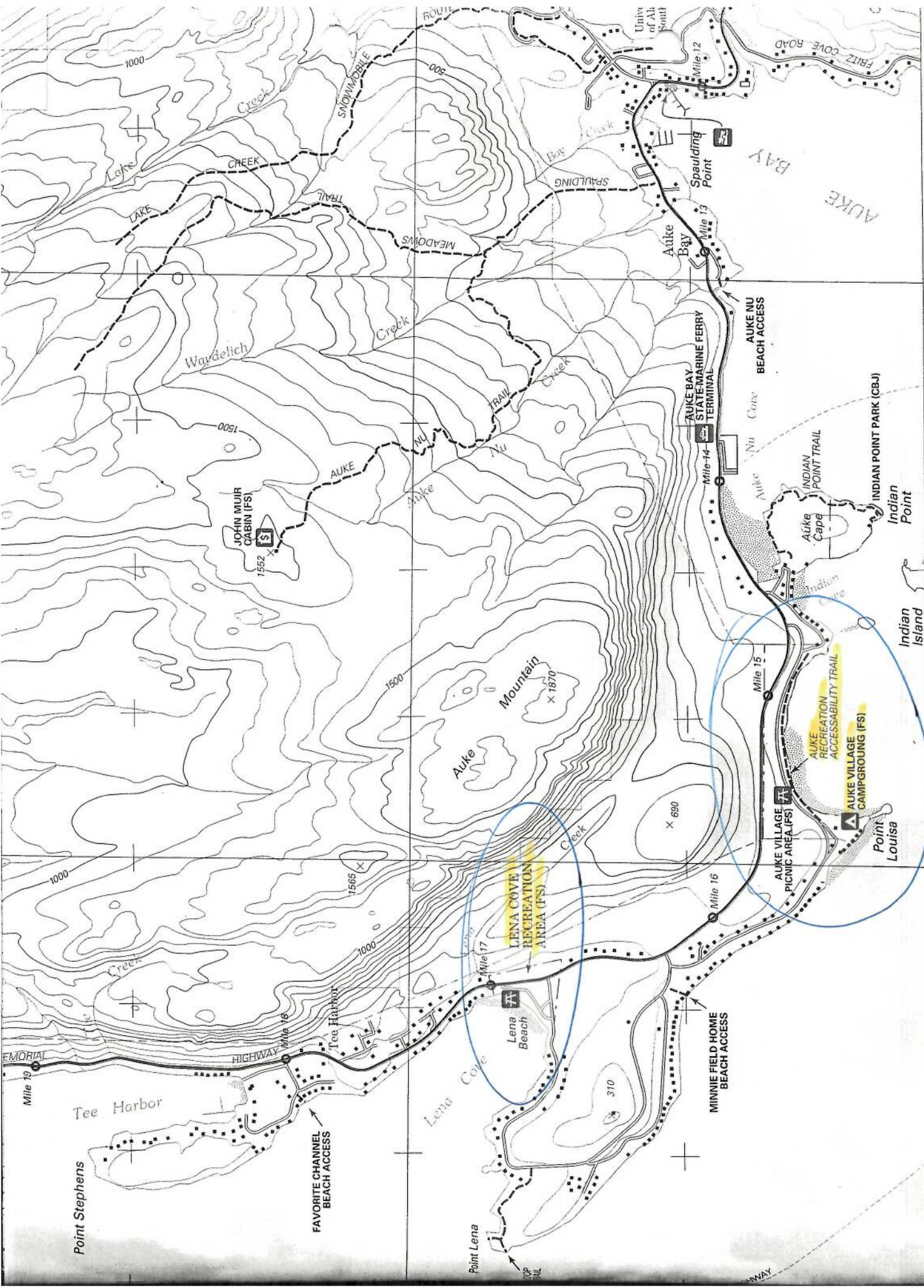

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571)
