The Hoosier National Forest has several maps available. These can be ordered by mail, on-line, or purchased at any of our offices.

Forest Map

Scale: 1/2 inch = 1 mile. One water-resistant map covers both districts of the Hoosier. Recreation information is also included on the map. Forest maps sell for \$10 each.

Topographic Maps

Scale: 1 inch = 2,000 feet. These maps are also known as 7.5 minute Quads. When ordering topographic maps, you must specify which map you want by quadrangle name. A map index to locate a specific quad is printed on the other side of this sheet. Topographic maps show Forest Service ownership as well as other topographic and cultural features. Each quad sells for \$8. There is a charge of \$3.50 per order for mailing any amount of topographic sheets ordered.

Charles C. Deam Wilderness Map

Scale: 1 inch = 2,000 feet. This topographic map of the entire wilderness area is printed in full color on water-resistant paper. The map shows trails and other features in the Wilderness area. Map sells for \$1.

How to Purchase a Map

These maps may be purchased from either the Tell City or Bedford office of the Hoosier NF. Office hours are 8 to 4:30 (local time), M-F. Sales are by credit card, cash, **check or money order payable to the US Forest Service**. Please report any errors you find.

National Geographic Trails Map

Scale: 1 inch = 1.1 mile. This topographic map features trail systems on the Forest including: the Charles C. Deam Wilderness trails, Birdseye, Brown County D, Celina and Two Lakes Loop, German Ridge, Hardin Ridge, Hemlock Cliffs, Hickory and Nebo Ridge, Lick Creek, Mogan Ridge, Oriole, Pioneer Mothers, Saddle and Tipsaw Lake, Shirley Creek, and Youngs Creek. Printed on waterproof/tearproof paper. The map sells for \$11.95 plus tax. It is sold through this office by the Eastern National Forests Interpretive Association. Checks for this map should be made out to "ENFIA" and a separate check written if other maps are also ordered from USDA. You can call in and order this map by credit card.


