

## **Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern**

### **Recommendations and Evaluations**

**Common Name:** Stevens' Tortricid Moth

**Scientific Name:** *Decodes stevensi*

**Recommendation:** Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### **Recommendation Rationale:**

Known only from one vicinity, Owl Canyon, along U.S. 285 in Larimer County. Habitat type is apparently pinyon-juniper/Mt. Mahogany. Location and habitat type appears to place this species just east and below Arapaho Roosevelt NF boundaries. Dennis Lowry indicated that pinyon does not extend onto the Arapaho Roosevelt. It is found on the Pawnee, but not with Mt. Mahogany. Therefore, it appears that this habitat does not occur in NFS lands.
