Recommendation: Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendation Rationale:

Knows to occur on Black Hills NF and Arapaho Roosevelt NF; likely to occur on Shoshone NF, Bighorn, and Thunder Basin. Occurs in British Columbia west to Sask in Canada. Also in Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho, Nevada, Montana, and Utah. Species is widespread, habitat exists as patches which are small or isolated limiting interactions between populations. Fire and noxious weed are greatest threats on NF lands. Habitat trend relatively stable, relatively resilient to disturbance.
