ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

Wild Rivers Ranger District

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Wild Rivers Ranger District as described in this order and attached map, located within the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest, until May 31, 2014, unless sooner rescinded:

Fire

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire along the Illinois River Road as described below, except in designated Forest Service fire rings. [36 CFR 261.52(a)]

Occupancy and Use

2. Parking or leaving a vehicle unattended inside the white lines along the Illinois River Road. [36 CFR 261.58(g)]

Description of Illinois River Road

Forest Service Road #4103 beginning at the Forest boundary in the Southwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 8, T.38S, R.8W., to the intersection with Forest Service Road #087 in the Southwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 33, T.37S., R.9W., Willamette Meridian.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
