

Order No. 08-13-02
Mendocino National Forest
Temporary Resource Closure

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b) and 16 USC 551, and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Covelo and Grindstone Ranger Districts of the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from January 8, 2013, through May 23, 2013.

Being on the National Forest System roads listed below:

1. Forest Road No. 24N21, from Hams Pass, then north to its terminus.
2. Two portions of Forest Road No. M1:
 - a. Indian Dick Rd., from Boardman Ridge, then north to its terminus.
 - b. Etsel Ridge Rd., from Bentley Ridge, then south to its intersection with Forest Road No. M61.
3. Forest Road No. 22N11, approximately 1 miles south of Forest Highway 7 past Bredehoft Place southeast to its intersection with Forest Highway 7.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) each of the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area, to the extent necessary to access their land.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
