Blueberry Patch Campground

Caring for the Land and Serving People

Description:

Blueberry Patch Campground is a small, semi-primitive campground located along Picnic Area Road (County Route 2), next to the large blueberry patch for which it is named. This is a popular spot to gather berries when they are in season. The berry patch features high bush as well as low bush blueberries. The campground gate is open from mid May through the end of November. Sites are available on a first come first serve basis. There is a \$10.00 per site per night camping fee. Envelopes for payment are available at the self pay station as you drive in.

Facilities:

Campground: There are nine campsites available on a first come first serve basis. Each has a fire pit, a tent pad, a picnic table and parking for up to two cars. Some of the picnic tables are handicap accessible. There are two handicap accessible vault toilets. This campground is designed for tents or small campers under 24 feet long. Dumpster service is provided. **There is no drinking water available.**

Day Use Area: There is a parking lot as you drive into the campground. If you prefer to hike, picnic, or gather berries without camping, you may park your car here.

Directions:

From the South, take State Route 14 North (Exit 52 off State Route 17) to Watkins Glen, NY. In Watkins Glen, turn right at the Fourth St intersection onto State Route 414 North. Go approximately 9 miles north, past the Hector Ranger Station of the Finger Lakes National Forest. 0.5 miles past the Ranger Station, turn right on Schuyler County Route 2. Travel for 4.0 miles east. Blueberry Patch Campground is on the right.

From the North, take State Route 414 South to Hector, NY (Exit 41 off I-90). In Hector, 1 mile past the Dandy Mini Mart, turn left onto County Route 2. Travel for 4.0 miles east. Blueberry Patch Campground is on the right.

Notes:

- Maximum length of stay is 14 days within a 30 day period
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- Check out time is 2:00 PM
- There is no dump station

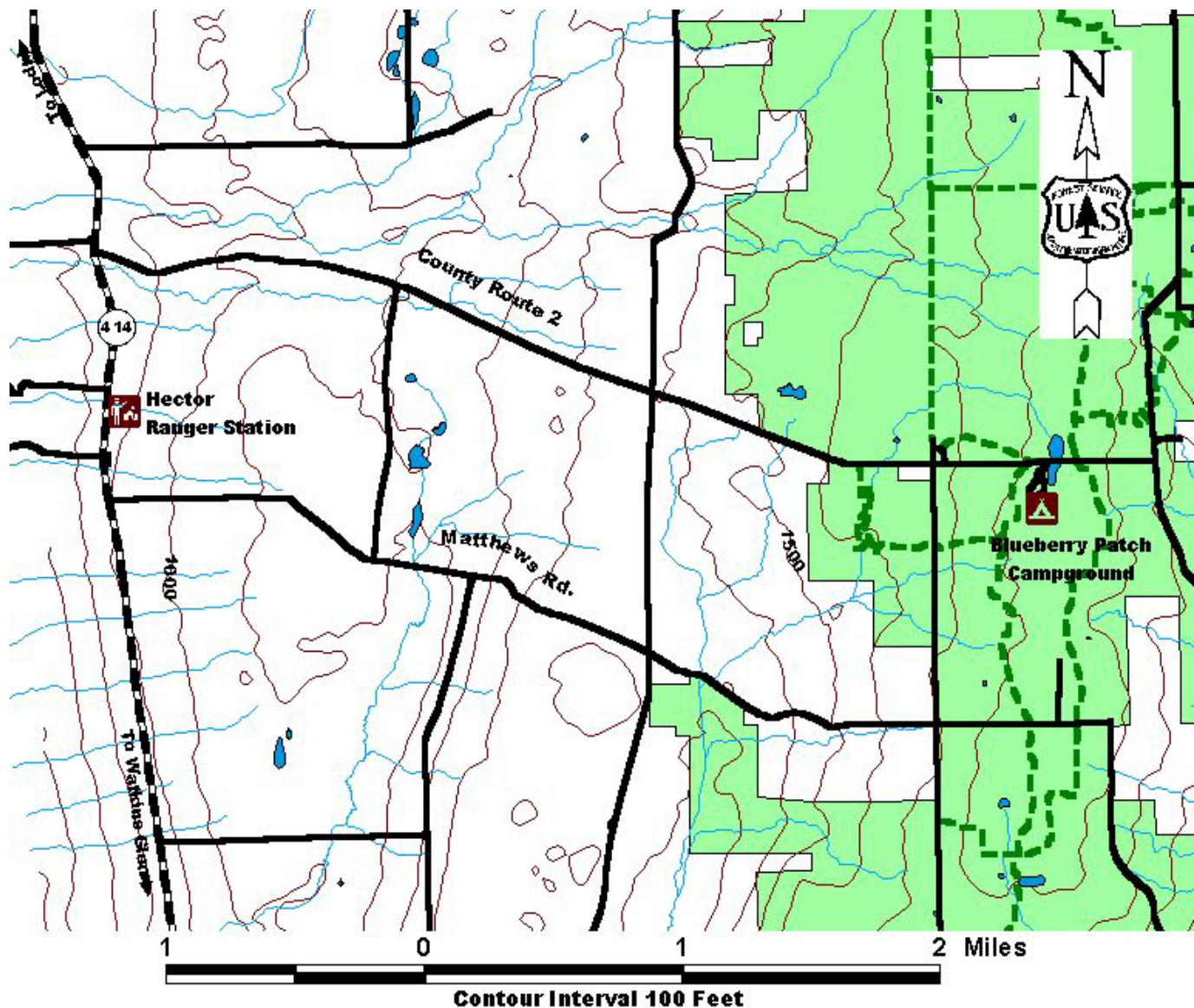
