

ORDER

FIRE, OCCUPANCY AND USE, AND ROADS AND TRAIL RESTRICTIONS

FRASER EXPERIMENTAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Fraser Experimental Forest until further notice:

I CAMPING

Camping except in Byers Creek Campground and in an area within one mile of St. Louis Lake. Camping is prohibited within an area of 100 feet from the shore of St. Louis Lake. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).

II ROADS AND TRAILS

- A. Use of motor vehicles, including snowmobiles, except on designated roads. 36 CFR 261.56.
- B. Use of motor vehicles, including snowmobiles, except on designated trails. 36 CFR 261.55 (a).
- C. Use of bicycles or skis except on roads and trails designated for their use. 36 CFR 261.53 (b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), The following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
