 Designated roads open to state licensed motorized vehicles and all nonmotorized travel

 Designated roads/trails open to all motorized vehicles, hiking, horseback riding, and mountain biking

 Designated roads that are closed sunset to sunrise

 Administrative Use only

 Designated trails open to motorized vehicles less than 50"

 Designated trails open to hiking

 Designated trails open to hiking, horseback riding, and mountain biking

 Designated trails open to motorized vehicles less than 50" and hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking

 Designated trails open to hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking with a May 15 to July 15 closure.

 Designated trails open to hiking and horseback riding

 Highway

 Unimproved or 4 wheel drive road: Suitable for high clearance vehicles

 Area closed to horseback riding
