

ORDER  
FIRE REGULATIONS  
PORT PIERRE NATIONAL GRASSLAND


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System Lands within the Fort Pierre National Grassland:

- 1) Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or charcoal grill, 36 CFR 261.52(a);
- 2) Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, or while stopped in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials, 36 CFR 261.52(d);
- 3) Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order, 36 CFR 261.52(j).

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission;
- 2) Any Federal, State, and local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
