

RELATED OPPORTUNITIES

Hiking, water recreation and wildlife viewing

SEASON OF USE

All year
Use may be limited by road conditions

ELEVATION

3400 feet

FACILITIES

23 Camp units
Grills
Picnic tables and vault toilets
Trash Service
Drinking water available during daylight hours
(solar-powered well pump)

LOCATION AND ACCESS

From Carefree, take Cave Creek Road/Forest Road (FR) 24 for 20 miles north to Seven Springs. The last 9 miles of FR 24 is an all-weather gravel road. The gravel portion of the road is narrow with blind curves.

FEES

\$4.00 per vehicle
Self Pay Fee Station

ATTRACTIONS

- The CCC (Civilian Conservation Corps) constructed this recreation site in 1934.
- Large sycamore trees next to a small creek that provide shade
- Though the water of the creek is only ankle-deep, it offers a cool respite from Arizona's summer heat.

CONSIDERATIONS

- Not recommended for trailers **over 16 feet**
- Private land nearby (working ranch): **No trespassing**
- **Do not** cross flooded roadways
- Use caution during the rainy season. The area (like all desert creeks) is prone to flash flooding.
