BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

The parking lot is situated near one accessible picnic unit. It has a raised grill and table; one end is wheelchair-accessible. There is an accessible restroom. The site has grades ranging from 5% to 10% slope over compacted dirt and is suitable for wheelchair users with proficient mobility.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 6 miles south of Globe. From Globe, take paved Jess Hayes Road southeast to the junction of Icehouse Canyon Road/Forest Road (FR) 112 and Sixshooter Canyon Road/Forest Road 222. Turn right and continue on FR 112 for 3 miles to the junction of FR 55 and FR 112. Stay left and continue following FR 122 for another 3 miles to the site.
