BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

The restroom facilities at Ramps #1 and #2 are accessible to most wheelchair users. There are accessible parking spaces at Ramp #2 and other at picnic sites.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 31 miles northeast of Mesa. From Mesa, travel 27 miles north on State Hwy. 87 to Bush Highway/Forest Road (FR) 204 and turn right. Follow Bush Highway for 4 miles to FR 206 and turn left. Follow FR 206 to the site. The entire route is on a busy paved road.

ATTRACTIONS

- This site has paved public boat launch ramps and shade ramadas.
- This area is a wonderful example of the Sonoran Desert habitat along a desert lake.

CONSIDERATIONS

- Day-use only
- Glass containers **not allow** in Saguaro Lake area
- Please use trash receptacles
- Telephone at entrance to the site
