RELATED OPPORTUNITIES

Boating, fishing, water recreation, wildlife-viewing and mountain biking

SEASON OF USE

February 16 - November 14
(Posted "Closed to Entry" Nov. 15 - Feb. 15 for wildlife protection)

ELEVATION

2151 feet

FEES

\$4.00 per vehicle (day-use)
\$2.00 per watercraft (day-use)

FACILITIES

Trash receptacles and portable toilets.
Paved roads and parking in day-use area

BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

The site offers limited access with compacted, stabilized decomposed granite. Shoreline slopes range from 5% to 10%. An accessible toilet is available adjacent to the day-use parking area.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is approximately 7 miles north of Roosevelt Dam.

From Mesa: Take State Hwy. 87 (Beeline Highway) north for approximately 60 miles to the junction of State Hwy. 87 and State Hwy. 188. Turn right (south) onto State Hwy. 188 and continue for 26 miles to Bermuda Flat.

From the Globe area: Take State Hwy. 188 north for 30 miles to the junction of State Hwy. 88 and State Hwy. 188. Continue north on State Hwy. 188 across the bridge for another six miles to the site.

ATTRACTIONS

- Located along the shoreline of central Arizona's largest lake.
- This site provides spectacular views of the Sierra Ancha Mountains and Four Peaks Wilderness.
- The gently sloping shoreline makes this a wonderful water recreation area.
- Miles of expansive grassy area near the shoreline lined with shade-providing mesquite trees.

CONSIDERATIONS

- **No drinking water** available
- Sewage dump facilities (no fee) are located 2 miles south on State Hwy. 188 at milepost # 249 across from Cholla Recreation Site.
- Rules and regulations are posted at all fee station areas. Please read and observe.
- Please use trash receptacles, when available, or **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Shorelines boat launching. Do not attempt to launch large boats at this site.
- Lake levels determine amount of spaces available
- This area is prone to flash floods. Camp out of flood areas and watch the weather carefully.
- Internal roads in camping areas are not paved.
