### RELATED OPPORTUNITIES

Boating, fishing, hiking, water recreation and wildlife-viewing

### SEASON OF USE

All year

### ELEVATION

2200 feet

### FACILITIES

Nine separate loops with toilets, central shower building, playground, event area, and sports field, lake access trails, and paved boat launch ramp. Individual camp units have fire rings with grills and picnic tables with adjacent parking.

### BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

The event area, group ramadas, picnic tables, showers, toilets and water hydrants are fully accessible.

### LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is approximately 8.5 miles south of Theodore Roosevelt Dam.

**From Mesa:** Take State Hwy. 87/Beeline Highway north for about 60 miles to its junction with State Hwy. 188. Turn right and follow State Hwy. 188 for 33 miles to its junction with State Hwy. 88. Continue on State Hwy. 188 south for another 7.5 miles to Forest Road (FR) 84/Grapevine Group Site. Turn left onto FR 84 for 2 miles to the site.

**From the Globe area:** Take State Hwy. 188 west for 23 miles to its junction with FR 84/Grapevine Group Site. Turn right onto FR 84 for 2 miles to the site.

### ATTRACTIONS

- Located on central Arizona's largest lake.
- Campfire or special interpretive programs about native wildlife, vegetation and cultural history are available upon request. For further information, contact the district ranger.

### FEES AND CAPACITIES

- Prepaid reservations are required. Call the Tonto Basin Ranger District for information.
- Loops accommodate up to 100 people for RV or tent camping and picnicking. Each loop has water hydrants, toilets, group ramadas, 13-25 individual camp units, and parking for 30-40 vehicles.

### CONSIDERATIONS

- Sewage dump facilities (no fee) are located 5 miles west of the State Hwy. 88/188 junction on State Hwy. 188 at milepost 249 across from Cholla Recreation Site.
- Rules and regulations are posted at host site. Please read and observe.
- Please use trash receptacles when available or **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Lake levels vary widely throughout the year
