South end: Bobtail Ridge Trail 194

North end: Forest Road (FR) 651

TRAIL INFORMATION

Trail use: Light to moderate

Trail difficulty: Easiest

Trail length: 0.8 miles

Season of Use: Spring - fall

USGS maps: Pinal Peak

Elevation: 7560 feet to 7640 feet

TRAIL NARRATIVE

This trail, combined with the Middle Trail 202, provides a connection between most of the trails that head out into the Pinal Mountains. The trail begins at Signal Peak. It crosses Forest Road (FR) 651 at the cattle guard and skirts the Pinal Campground on the west.

ATTRACTIONS

- Much of the trail follows a pine-covered ridge with spectacular views.
- The Pinal Mountains are noted for their scenic beauty and raggedness.

CONSIDERATIONS

- Do not drink untreated water. Giardia, a protozoan, is in many water impoundments and streams.
- If you PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Carry an adequate supply of drinking water. One gallon/per person/ per day is recommended during hot periods.
