North end: Forest Road (FR) 138 (Sixshooter Road)

TRAIL INFORMATION

Trail use: Light

Trail difficulty: More difficult

Trail length: 4.3 miles

Season of Use: Spring - fall

USGS maps: Pinal Peak

Elevation: 3880 feet to 5600 feet

ATTRACTIONS

- This trail was originally a tollroad built in 1883 to open a route through the mountains to the Pioneer Mine.
- This trail offers scenic views of Upper Pinal Creek.

TRAIL NARRATIVE

From the Lower East Mountain Trailhead, the Tollroad Trail 200 goes east, then heads northeast about .2 mile to its junction with East Mountain Trail 214. Continue left on Tollroad Trail 200, heading north. The trail turns to the right and crosses the creek, then winds along the east side of a steep canyon, through thick stands of pine. After another 1.5 mile, the trail crosses an old fence line.

Two miles into the hike, the trail intersects with the Una Del Oso Trail 201. The Tollroad Trail continues north paralleling the drainage while the Una Del Oso trail climbs northeast up to Forest Road (FR) 112. After 3.5 miles, Check Dam Trail 190 intersects on the left. At 4.0 miles, there is a fence with a gate (please close gate after passing through). At its northern end, the trail meets FR 138 (Sixshooter Road).

CONSIDERATIONS

- Do not drink untreated water. Giardia, a protozoan, is in many water impoundments and streams.
- **If you PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Carry an adequate supply of drinking water. One gallon/per person/per day is recommended during hot periods.
