Roads analysis is not a decision-making process, but will produce an informational report to be used by district rangers in making future site-specific road management decisions. Public input and scientific analysis will be integrated into the report to help the Forest Service understand the current uses and issues related to the forest road system. The public may provide input on social, cultural, economic, or environmental issues pertaining to roads in the analysis area. Specific information on historical road use, use patterns, primary destinations, and desired uses of forest roads is also encouraged.
