Sevenmile Road To Hiker Trailhead Closed

Klamath Falls, OR - If you're planning to hike into the Seven Lakes Basin in Sky Lakes Wilderness in the next month or so, you should plan to add an extra mile and a half to your stroll. The Klamath Ranger District is in the process of constructing a new trailhead for horses alongside Forest Road 3334, one and a half miles from the hiker trailhead at the end of the road. When construction is completed, a tie trail will allow horse users to ride through the woods from the horse trailhead to the hiker trailhead. Until construction is completed, Forest Road 3334 is closed to motorized vehicles from the horse trailhead to the hiker trailhead, a distance of approximately one and a half miles. Equestrians and hikers can all park at the horse trailhead and walk up the road to the hiker trailhead where they can join the original trail into Seven Lakes Basin. The vehicle closure is necessary as a safety precaution to prevent possible collisions between horses and vehicles on the narrow stretch of the road. The closure is expected to remain in effect until late September. For more information, contact the Klamath Ranger District at 541-885-3400.
